DEPOSIT AND REGISTRATION

Preregistration begins February 3, 2020 for current participants. Registration opens on February 10, 2020 for new students. Our program follows the Hamilton Southeastern Schools calendar for all vacations, holidays, half-days and winter-related cancellations.

Registration is for the entire school year, August 17-May 14. A non-refundable deposit of \$50 is required at registration, and will be credited toward tuition for the last month (May).

Payment for preschool may only be made through monthly draft.
